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#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Receive and file the Cliffwater Quarterly Performance Review presentation for the periods ending March 31, 2023 for the Absolute Return portfolio, and the periods ending December 31, 2022 for the Private Equity, Private Credit, and Real Assets portfolios.

#### **PURPOSE**

This item complies with SCERS' investment policy statement reporting requirements and contributes to the effective management and oversight of investment activities.

#### **SCERS ALTERNATIVE ASSETS PORTFOLIO RETURNS**

This memorandum provides a summarized table of SCERS' Alternative Assets period returns, which complements Cliffwater's Quarterly Performance Review, and highlights notable manager performance, along with any recent alternative investments made by SCERS. The returns for the private market asset classes are shown in the table below, and provided within Cliffwater's reports, are lagged a quarter and reflect valuations as of December 31, 2022.

## **SCERS PORTFOLIO RESULTS**

For the reporting quarter ended December 31, 2022:

- SCERS' Private Equity portfolio underperformed against its benchmark, -0.2% versus 0.7%. The underperformance was primarily in SCERS' venture capital strategies as the public markets remain subdued.
- SCERS' Private Credit portfolio underperformed against its benchmark return, 2.2% versus 2.8%, as a number of SCERS' direct lending strategies took mark-to-market downgrades due to rising interest rates and widening interest rate spreads.
- SCERS' Real Assets portfolio underperformed against its benchmark, 2.1% versus 3.4%. A number of SCERS' energy and power strategies pulled back due to the decline in oil and gas prices.

For the reporting quarter ended March 31, 2023, SCERS' Absolute Return portfolio outperformed the HFRI Fund of Funds Conservative Index return, +1.2% versus +1.0%, with the Diversifying Portfolio outperforming the index (+1.2% versus +1.0%), and the Growth-Oriented portfolio, which is being liquidated, underperforming (+0.5% versus +0.9%). The Diversifying Portfolio relative outperformance was due primarily to the Market Neutral strategies (+2.7% versus +1.0%).

# Absolute Return Portfolio Performance Summary – as of March 31, 2023

## Diversifying Strategies

- The Diversifying Portfolio returned 1.22% in Q1 and 0.93% for the one-year period ending March 31, 2023
  - Outperformed the HFRI Conservative FoF Index benchmark by 23 bps in Q1 and 2 bps for the one-year period
  - Slightly trailed the T-bills + 2% long term objective by 5 bps (annualized) over the trailing 5-year period
- Sculptor (+4.90%), Two Sigma (+3.91%), and Laurion (+3.76%) led performance in Q1
  - Graham Tactical Trend (-6.51%) and PSquared (-1.28%) saw declines during Q1
- LMR (+6.90%), MW Global Opps (+4.83%), and Aristeia (+4.13%) provided the best performance over the one-year period
  - Although SCERS fully redeemed from Eisler during the period, Eisler had a material negative impact on performance during the trailing one-year period; Sculptor (-4.71%) and Two Sigma (-1.06%) also reported negative returns for the one-year period

## Growth Oriented Strategies

- The portfolio was significantly downsized in Q1 '22 following the 2021 decision to eliminate the Growth Oriented Portfolio
  - The only investments in the portfolio are the remaining holdings of the Grosvenor Growth portfolio
    - Grosvenor Growth will continue to wind-down as that portfolio's liquidity allows
  - The portfolio market value totaled \$8.7 million at March 31, 2023
- The Growth Oriented Portfolio returned 0.52% in Q1 and -1.63% for the one-year period ending March 31, 2023

## Portfolio risk and market sensitivity are at expectations for the Diversifying portfolio

- Diversifying Portfolio
  - Target standard deviation < 25% of global equities, with an equity beta < 0.2 and equity correlation < 0.5
    - Standard deviation of 3.39% compared to the ACWI standard deviation of 14.19% since December 2011 (24% ratio)
    - Portfolio equity beta of 0.12 with an equity correlation of 0.48
- The Growth Oriented portfolio is being eliminated in connection with the 2021 asset liability study



# Absolute Return Portfolios Cumulative Performance – December 2011 to March 2023

The Diversifying portfolio is above its T-bills + 2% long term objective though trails the HFRI Fund of Funds Conservative Index over this period

Despite sharp declines in Q1 2020 and 2022, the Growth Oriented portfolio continued to meet the T-bills + 5% long term objective and remained ahead of the Fund of Funds Index + 1% benchmark into the portfolio's wind-down

Showing cumulative performance (growth of \$1) for each portfolio since the initial restructuring of the Absolute Return portfolio in December 2011

- The prior exposure of the Absolute Return portfolio was only Equity Long/Short fund of funds investments



## Private Equity Portfolio – as of December 31, 2022

The Private Equity portfolio's net IRR since inception is 16.85%, versus the Cambridge Associates benchmark IRR of 14.27%

- The long-term Policy objective (Russell 3000 + 3%) has a 14.60% IRR over this period

The portfolio returned -0.2% in Q4 while public equity markets rebounded sharply during the quarter (ACWI +9.8%)

- Negative performance came primarily from the portfolio's Venture Capital and Growth Equity funds
  - Linden III, CRV Select, Trinity XII, RRJ II, Marlin Heritage, and Khosla Ventures IV reported the largest declines in Q4
  - However, a number of the portfolio's funds did show gains for the quarter, largely offsetting these declines
- Distributions slowed during the quarter, reflecting a general slowdown in private equity exits in the second half of 2022
  - \$42.8 million in distributions, led by Marlin Heritage Europe, Thoma Bravo XII, TOP IV, Trinity Ventures XI, and NEA 15
- For the calendar year 2022, the portfolio returned -7.7% while public equities saw significant declines (ACWI -18.4%)

Despite the recent performance slowdown, longer-term performance remains quite strong across most of the funds

- Double-digit net IRRs for all vintage years prior to 2020, with most vintage years exceeding peer universes
- Summit Europe II (77.2%), Summit VC IV (41.0%), AKKR IV (39.0%), Spectrum VII (38.7%), Waterland V (35.1%), Spectrum VIII (33.5%), and Trinity Ventures XII (31.2%) are leading performance among SCERS' more mature funds

The legacy fund of funds, comprising 4.5% of the Private Equity portfolio, were mostly down 5 – 6% during the quarter


- The legacy fund of funds distributed \$5.3 million during the quarter

Changes during the quarter


- SCERS committed \$100 million to a co-investment fund managed by Ardian during Q4
  - SCERS also committed \$30 million each to a venture capital fund and a buyout fund (both re-ups) in Q1 2023
- \$53.8 million in new contributions, \$42.8 million in distributions
- Total portfolio gain decreased by \$3.4 million while the total portfolio IRR decreased by 0.45%



  - Most of the funds generated returns between 1% to 5% for the quarter
- Longer term performance remains steady despite modest sell-offs in Q1 2020 and during the first half of 2022
  - 8.4% net IRR for the 3-year period and 8.1% net IRR for the 5-year period

### Changes during the quarter


- SCERS committed \$80 million in total to two Direct Lending funds during Q4
  - Q4 commitments included \$40 million to an infrastructure debt fund and \$40 million to a specialty lending fund (re-up)
- \$27.1 million in new contributions, \$15.1 million in distributions
- Total portfolio gain increased by \$8.1 million while the total portfolio IRR increased by 0.03%

## Real Assets Portfolio – as of December 31, 2022

The Real Assets portfolio's net IRR since inception is 12.14%, versus the blended benchmark return of 8.02%

- The Real Assets portfolio includes private Infrastructure, Energy and Power, and Agriculture, Timber and Other
- Real Assets is part of the broader Real Return asset category

The Real Assets portfolio is primarily Infrastructure and Energy and Power partnerships

- Since inception net IRRs of 11.3% for Infrastructure and 14.0% for Energy and Power
- Performance of the Energy and Power partnerships was materially impacted by significant markdowns in Q1 2020
  - However, most of the Energy and Power (particularly upstream energy) partnerships have rebounded sharply since Q3 2020
- Infrastructure partnerships saw smaller declines in Q1 2020 and have maintained good performance since inception

The Real Assets portfolio generated a 2.1% net return in Q4


- The portfolio's Energy and Power funds generally led performance during the quarter
  - Many of the Energy and Power funds reported returns between 1% and 10% in Q4
  - Tailwater IV, EnCap Flatrock III, and EnCap IX each gained more than 10% in Q4
- The Infrastructure funds also reported good performance, mostly returning between 1% and 5% during the quarter
- Quantum VI (energy) and ACM II (agriculture) were the laggards and reported negative returns in Q4


- SCERS made no new commitments to Real Assets funds in Q4
